



01 The Straw Theatre:
Control over various facade options allow for interesting aesthetics. This visual illustrates how the straw theatre could create something that is both exciting and dynamic for both performers & visitors.

- A Ex. wall detail:**
- 01 Black curtain - fixed to scaffolding above - used as & when required
 - 02 Structural scaffolding section
 - 03 Scaffold sheeting - fixed / tied back to scaffolding structure
 - 04 Cavity between scaffolding and straw-bale membrane / facade
 - 05 Double straw-bale membrane - to provide structural support for facade

- B Straw-bale pocket detail:**
- B1: plan
- 06 Heavy duty plastic ties used to support scaffold boards used for openings
 - 07 Scaffold board used as lintel to support straw-bales above
- B2: elevation
- 08 Heavy duty plastic ties used to tie straw-bale sections together
 - 09 Facade opening

- C Roof + ext. wall detail:**
- 10 Straw-bales supported by lattice of horizontal scaffold tubing
 - 11 Scaffold sheeting - DPM fixed / tied at various intervals
 - 12 MDF gutter lined with scaffold sheeting / waterproof membrane
 - 13 Horizontal scaffold tubing supported by light weight 450mm truss system
 - 14 450mm light weight truss
 - 15 Scaffold vertical tubing / standards
 - 16 Scaffold horizontal support / bracing
 - 17 Heavy duty plastic ties used to tie / fix scaffold sheeting to structure / straw-bales
